The final match schedule is typically confirmed approximately 7-10 days prior to the relevant matchweek, although some fixtures may be confirmed earlier. As a result, the timing of included experiences may be adjusted within the itinerary to align with the official fixture list. All planned inclusions will be delivered as outlined, though they may take place on different days. For the most accurate match date, please refer to the table on the itinerary page, which will be updated as soon as the fixture is officially confirmed.

Take your seat inside one of Europe's most atmospheric stadiums, Spotify Camp Nou, and watch the team play the kind of football that's shaped how the rest of the world plays the game. Before or after the match, depending on kick-off, enjoy a behind-the-scenes stadium tour and settle in for a delicious spread of traditional tapas, beer, and wine, at an authentic local spot – on us, ¡Salud!

Depending on kick-off time, your stadium tour may be included on this day. If that's not possible, don't worry – it'll be moved to another part of your football trip.

Like all top-level football fixtures, La Liga match schedules are subject to change. Initial fixture confirmations are typically announced 3–5 weeks before departure, with the final schedule usually confirmed 7–10 days before the match. Are there Itinerary notes?

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What important notes should I be aware of before the trip?

- 1. Match Schedules Can Change:** La Liga fixtures are subject to change due to television selections, European competitions, and other scheduling requirements. Matches originally scheduled for Saturday may move to Friday, Sunday, or Monday. Your tour itinerary may be adjusted accordingly, but all included experiences will still be delivered. For the most accurate match date, please refer to the table on the itinerary page, which will be updated as soon as the fixture is officially confirmed. To accommodate any schedule changes, we recommend booking flexible airfare for your Away Games departure.
- 2. Weather:** Weather in Madrid and Barcelona varies throughout the season. Summers are typically hot and dry, while spring, autumn, and winter can bring cooler temperatures and occasional rain. Pack comfortable layers, sun protection, a light waterproof jacket, and suitable walking shoes. Although many seating areas are covered, you may still be exposed to the elements when entering and exiting the stadium.
- 3. Expect Plenty of Walking:** You'll explore the city on foot, use public transportation, and navigate busy matchday crowds. Comfortable walking shoes are highly recommended. Some stadiums require climbing stairs or walking significant distances to reach hospitality areas and seating sections.
- 4. Stadium Security Is Strict:** Bag checks are standard at all La Liga stadiums. Large bags, professional cameras, outside food and drink, and other prohibited items may not be permitted. Security procedures vary by stadium, so please follow the instructions provided by your CEO and stadium staff.
- 5. Wear Your Team Colours Respectfully / Avoid Opposing Team Colours:** Home team shirts, scarves, and merchandise are encouraged. If attending as a neutral supporter, avoid wearing the opposing team's colours in home supporter sections, as this may not be permitted. Your CEO will advise on any club-specific guidelines.
- 6. Alcohol Policies:** Alcohol may be available in some hospitality areas, depending on the club and package. However, alcohol is generally not sold inside Spanish football stadiums, and local laws and stadium policies apply. Your CEO will advise if any hospitality package includes food or beverages before the match.
- 7. Be Flexible:** Football tours are built around the match experience, and occasionally schedules may change due to fixture updates. A flexible attitude will help ensure you enjoy every aspect of your trip.
- 8. Bring Your Football Passion:** Whether you're a lifelong supporter or attending your first La Liga match, be ready to immerse yourself in Spain's football culture. Some of the best moments happen away from the pitch—sharing stories with fellow travellers, enjoying tapas and local bars, and discovering the rich football heritage of Madrid or Barcelona.
- 9. Local Football Match Experience:** As part of your tour, you'll attend an additional live football match to experience the game beyond La Liga. This may include a match featuring a local professional club from Spain's lower divisions, a women's fixture, or another regional competition, depending on the schedule during your visit. Your CEO will confirm the fixture details during the tour and provide information on transportation, timing, and matchday logistics. These matches often offer a more intimate atmosphere and provide a unique perspective on Spanish football culture.
- 10. Seat Location:** If you'd like to get a better idea of your view before matchday, you can use a stadium seat-viewing website to preview your seat location. Your seat will be located within the Category A Seating: <https://3ddigitalvenue.com/3dmap/clients/fcbarcelona/>

What is the role of the group leader during this trip?

This G Adventures group trip is accompanied by one of our group leaders, otherwise known as a Chief Experience Officer (CEO). The aim of the group leader is to take the hassle out of your travels and to help you have the best trip possible. They will provide information on the places you are travelling through, offer suggestions for things to do and see, recommend great local eating venues and introduce you to our local friends. While not being guides in the traditional sense you can expect them to have a broad general knowledge of the countries visited on the trip, including historical, cultural, religious and social aspects.

We also use local guides where we think more specific knowledge will add to the enjoyment of the places we are visiting - we think it's the best of both worlds.

What are the meals like on this trip?

Eating is a big part of traveling. G Adventures understands the importance of breakfast to start your day, we strive to include a basic breakfast wherever possible. A typical breakfast may include toast, coffee and tea, however this may vary depending on the city. Should breakfast not be included, your CEO can suggest some local options.

Travelling with G Adventures you experience the vast array of wonderful food that is available out in the world. Generally meals are not included in the trip price when there is a choice of eating options, to give you the maximum flexibility in deciding where, what and with whom to eat. It also gives you more budgeting flexibility, though generally food is cheap. Our groups tend to eat together to enable you to taste a larger variety of dishes and enjoy each other's company. There is no obligation to do this though. Your CEO will be able to suggest favourite restaurants during your trip.

What are the modes of transportation on my trip?

Is there an extra cost for travelling solo?

We believe solo travellers should not have to pay more to travel so our group trips are designed for shared accommodation and do not involve a single supplement. Single travellers joining group trips are paired in twin or multi-share accommodation with someone of the same sex for the duration of the trip. Some of our Independent trips are designed differently and solo travellers on these itineraries must pay the single trip price.

What are the joining instructions?

For details of your joining hotel please refer to your tour voucher, G Account, the G Adventures App or contact your travel agent.

An arrival transfer from Barcelona Airport is included when you arrive on Day 1, or if you arrive up to three days prior provided that you have booked your pre-accommodation through G Adventures in our joining hotel. Due to customer experience and quality considerations, all services related to the tour must be continuous.

Our driver will be waiting for you with a G Adventures sign, and they will be waiting for you outside the luggage hall. If for any reason you are not met at the airport, please call our local support line. If you are unable to make contact for whatever reason, please make your way to the joining point hotel via taxi.

Please note that in order to arrive in time for your welcome meeting, we recommend travellers to arrive by 3PM.

Upon arrival to your Joining Hotel (note that check-in time will be in the afternoon), look for a note or bulletin board in the reception with a note from your CEO. This note will give the details of your Welcome Meeting on day 1, where you will get a chance to meet your CEO and other travellers, as well as learn more about how the tour will run. If you don't see a note, please ask reception for details!

If you are arriving later and will miss the Welcome Meeting, your CEO will leave a note at reception for you with any information you may need, and with morning instructions for the next day.

What happens if I experience problems when arriving?

We don't expect any problems, and nor should you, but if for any reason you are unable to commence your trip as scheduled, please refer to the emergency contact details provided in this dossier and contact us as soon as possible. If you have a pre-booked transfer, and you have not made contact with our representative within 30 minutes of clearing customs and immigration, we recommend that you make your own way to the Starting Point hotel, following the Joining Instructions. Please apply to your travel agent on your return for a refund of the transfer cost if this occurs.

What should be on my packing list?

What are the visas and entry requirements for my trip?

All countries require a valid passport (with a minimum 6 months validity). Contact your local embassy or consulate for the most up-to-date visa requirements, or see your travel agent. It is your own responsibility to have the correct travel documentation. Visa requirements for your trip will vary depending on where you are from and where you are going. We keep the following information up to date as far as possible, but rules do change and sometimes without warning. While we provide the following information in good faith, it is vital that you check the information yourself and understand that you are fully responsible for your own visa requirements.

For other nationalities, travelling in Europe has been simplified with the introduction of the Schengen visa. As a visitor to the Schengen area (Austria, Germany, Netherlands, Belgium, Greece, Norway, Denmark, Iceland, Portugal, Finland, Italy, Spain, France, Luxembourg, Sweden, Czech Republic, Hungary, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia and Switzerland) you will enjoy the many advantages of this unified visa system. Generally speaking with a Schengen visa, you may enter one Schengen country and travel freely throughout the Schengen region during the validity of your visa. There are limited border controls at Schengen borders, if any at all.

Please note that the UK and Ireland are NOT part of the Schengen agreement.

A Schengen visa is applied for at the Embassy or Consulate of the Schengen country in which you will be spending the most nights on your trip to the Schengen space. If you are only visiting one country on your trip then you apply for your visa at the Consulate of this Schengen country.

As of 2025, various European countries are introducing ETIAS travel authorisation as an entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals.

We highly recommend you checking in advance how your nationality and country/s you are visiting may be affected. Further details can be found [here](#)

As of February 2026, dual British citizens travelling to the United Kingdom should carry either a valid British passport, or a Certificate of Entitlement to the Right of Abode, held digitally through a UKVI account and linked to a foreign passport. An ETA is not an alternative option. British citizens are not eligible for ETA's, even if they are travelling on a non-UK passport.

What should I know about currency, credit cards, and exchanging money while on this tour?

Credit cards and debit cards are very useful for cash advances. Visa cards are the most widely accepted cards. While ATMs are commonly available, there are no guarantees that your credit or debit cards will actually work. Check with your bank. You should be aware when purchasing products or services on a credit card, that a fee usually applies. Do not rely on credit or debit cards as your only source of money. A combination of Euros, Pounds, and cards is best. Always take more rather than less, as you don't want to spoil the trip by constantly feeling short of funds.

How much emergency money should I bring on this trip?

Please also make sure you have access to at least an additional USD \$200 (or equivalent) as an 'emergency' fund, to be used when circumstances outside our control (ex. a natural disaster) require a change to our planned route. This is a rare occurrence!

What activities are optional on this trip?

What rules should I know before joining this trip?

Illegal drugs will not be tolerated on any trips. Possessing or using drugs not only contravenes the laws of the land but also puts the rest of the group at risk. Smoking marijuana and opium is a part of local culture in some parts of the world but is not acceptable for our travellers. Our philosophy of travel is one of respect towards everyone we encounter and in particular the local people who make the world the special place it is. The exploitation of people in the sex trade is completely contrary to this philosophy. Our CEOs have the right to expel any member of the group if drugs are found in their possession or if they utilize the services of paid sex workers, in any capacity.

Is travel insurance required for my trip?

Travel insurance is compulsory in order to participate on any of our trips. When travelling on a group trip, you will not be permitted to join the group until evidence of travel insurance has been sighted by your leader, who will take note of your insurance details. When selecting a travel insurance policy we require that at a minimum you are covered for medical expenses including emergency evacuation and repatriation. A minimum coverage of USD200,000 is required. We strongly recommend that the policy also covers personal liability, cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects. Some tours include adventure activities that require extra coverage (e.g. crampon use); please review your itinerary and make sure that you are covered for all included activities. If you have credit card insurance we require proof of purchase of the trip (a receipt of credit card statement) with a credit card in your name. Contact your bank for details of their participating insurer, the level of coverage and emergency contact telephone number.

How old must I be to join this trip?
