Today's the day. Your VIP Manchester United matchday begins with private group transportation and curated stops en route – supporter pubs alive with the kind of pre-match energy only this club generates. At the Theatre of Dreams you enter through the dedicated hospitality entrance and take your luxury padded seat in the North East Quadrant, lounge access throughout. Complimentary hot food on arrival, a match programme and half-time tea and coffee. Football at its most storied.

Depending on kick-off time, your stadium tour may be included on this day. If that's not possible, don't worry – it'll be moved to another part of your football trip.

Like all top-level fixtures, match scheduling can shift. Premier League match dates are typically confirmed around six weeks before departure, and your match may take place on Saturday, Sunday, or Monday once the final schedule is released. You will be notified once your matchday is confirmed.

Are there Itinerary notes?

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What important notes should I be aware of before the trip?

- 1. Match Schedules Can Change:** Premier League fixtures are subject to change due to television selections, cup competitions, and other scheduling requirements. Matches originally scheduled for Saturday may move to Sunday, or Monday. Your tour itinerary may be adjusted accordingly, but all included experiences will still be delivered. For the most accurate match date, please refer to the table on the itinerary page, which will be updated as soon as the fixture is officially confirmed.
- 2. Weather: Pack for All Weather Conditions.** English weather can be unpredictable, even during spring and summer. Bring comfortable layers, a waterproof jacket, and suitable walking shoes. Stadiums are largely open-air venues, so be prepared for rain, wind, or cooler temperatures.
- 3. Expect Plenty of Walking:** You'll explore the city on foot, use public transportation, and navigate busy matchday crowds. Comfortable walking shoes are highly recommended. Some stadiums require climbing stairs to access seating areas.
- 4. Stadium Security Is Strict:** Bag checks are standard at all Premier League stadiums. Large bags, professional cameras, and certain prohibited items may not be permitted. Check stadium regulations before travelling.
- 5. Wear Your Team Colours Respectfully / Avoid Opposing Team Colors:** Hometeam shirts, scarves, and merchandise are encouraged. If attending as a neutral supporter, avoid wearing opposing team colours in home supporter sections as this is not permitted. Your CEO will advise on any club-specific considerations.
- 6. Alcohol Policies:** Alcohol may be available in hospitality areas and stadium concourses. However, drinking is not permitted while watching the match from your seat at Premier League grounds. Local licensing laws and stadium policies apply.
- 7. Be Flexible:** Football tours are built around the match experience, and occasionally timings may change. A flexible attitude will help ensure you enjoy every aspect of the trip.
- 8. Bring Your Football Passion:** Whether you're a lifelong supporter or attending your first Premier League match, be ready to immerse yourself in the culture. Some of the best moments happen away from the pitch—sharing stories with fellow travellers, exploring local pubs, and experiencing the city's football heritage.
- 9. Local Football Match Experience:** As part of your tour, you'll attend an additional live football match to experience the game beyond the Premier League. This match may take place in any of England's football tiers below the Premier League, including the English Football League, National League system, or the women's game. The specific fixture will depend on local schedules and availability during your travel dates. Your CEO will confirm the match details during the tour and provide any relevant information regarding transportation, timing, and matchday logistics. While the level of play may vary, these matches often provide some of the most authentic football atmospheres and offer a unique insight into England's rich football culture.

What is the role of the group leader during this trip?

This G Adventures group trip is accompanied by one of our group leaders, otherwise known as a Chief Experience Officer (CEO). The aim of the group leader is to take the hassle out of your travels and to help you have the best trip possible. They will provide information on the places you are travelling through, offer suggestions for things to do and see, recommend great local eating venues and introduce you to our local friends. While not being guides in the traditional sense you can expect them to have a broad general knowledge of the countries visited on the trip, including historical, cultural, religious and social aspects.

We also use local guides where we think more specific knowledge will add to the enjoyment of the places we are visiting - we think it's the best of both worlds.

What are the meals like on this trip?

Eating is a big part of traveling. G Adventures understands the importance of breakfast to start your day, we strive to include a basic breakfast wherever possible. A typical breakfast may include toast, coffee and tea, however this may vary depending on the city. Should breakfast not be included, your CEO can suggest some local options.

Travelling with G Adventures you experience the vast array of wonderful food that is available out in the world. Generally meals are not included in the trip price when there is a choice of eating options, to give you the maximum flexibility in deciding where, what and with whom to eat. It also gives you more budgeting flexibility, though generally food is cheap. Our groups tend to eat together to enable you to taste a larger variety of dishes and enjoy each other's company. There is no obligation to do this though. Your CEO will be able to suggest favourite restaurants during your trip.

What are the modes of transportation on my trip?

Is there an extra cost for travelling solo?

We believe solo travellers should not have to pay more to travel so our group trips are designed for shared accommodation and do not involve a single supplement. Single travellers joining group trips are paired in twin or multi-share accommodation with someone of the same sex for the duration of the trip. Some of our Independent trips are designed differently and solo travellers on these itineraries must pay the single trip price.

What are the joining instructions?

For details of your joining hotel please refer to your tour voucher, G Account, the G Adventures App or contact your travel agent.

An arrival transfer from Manchester Airport is included when you arrive on Day 1, or if you arrive up to three days prior provided that you have booked your pre-accommodation through G Adventures in our joining hotel. Due to customer experience and quality considerations, all services related to the tour must be continuous.

Our driver will be waiting for you with a G Adventures sign, and they will be waiting for you outside the luggage hall. If for any reason you are not met at the airport, please call our local support line. If you are unable to make contact for whatever reason, please make your way to the joining point hotel via taxi.

Please note that in order to arrive in time for your welcome meeting, we recommend travellers to arrive by 3PM.

Upon arrival to your Joining Hotel (note that check-in time will be in the afternoon), look for a note or bulletin board in the reception with a note from your CEO. This note will give the details of your Welcome Meeting on day 1, where you will get a chance to meet your CEO and other travellers, as well as learn more about how the tour will run. If you don't see a note, please ask reception for details!

If you are arriving later and will miss the Welcome Meeting, your CEO will leave a note at reception for you with any information you may need, and with morning instructions for the next day.

What happens if I experience problems when arriving?

We don't expect any problems, and nor should you, but if for any reason you are unable to commence your trip as scheduled, please refer to the emergency contact details provided in this dossier and contact us as soon as possible. If you have a pre-booked transfer, and you have not made contact with our representative within 30 minutes of clearing customs and immigration, we recommend that you make your own way to the Starting Point hotel, following the Joining Instructions. Please apply to your travel agent on your return for a refund of the transfer cost if this occurs.

What should be on my packing list?

What are the visas and entry requirements for my trip?

All countries require a valid passport (with a minimum 6 months validity). Contact your local embassy or consulate for the most up-to-date visa requirements, or see your travel agent. It is your own responsibility to have the correct travel documentation. Visa requirements for your trip will vary depending on where you are from and where you are going. We keep the following information up to date as far as possible, but rules do change and sometimes without warning. While we provide the following information in good faith, it is vital that you check the information yourself and understand that you are fully responsible for your own visa requirements.

For other nationalities, travelling in Europe has been simplified with the introduction of the Schengen visa. As a visitor to the Schengen area (Austria, Germany, Netherlands, Belgium, Greece, Norway, Denmark, Iceland, Portugal, Finland, Italy, Spain, France, Luxembourg, Sweden, Czech Republic, Hungary, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia and Switzerland) you will enjoy the many advantages of this unified visa system. Generally speaking with a Schengen visa, you may enter one Schengen country and travel freely throughout the Schengen region during the validity of your visa. There are limited border controls at Schengen borders, if any at all.

Please note that the UK and Ireland are NOT part of the Schengen agreement.

A Schengen visa is applied for at the Embassy or Consulate of the Schengen country in which you will be spending the most nights on your trip to the Schengen space. If you are only visiting one country on your trip then you apply for your visa at the Consulate of this Schengen country.

As of 2025, various European countries are introducing ETIAS travel authorisation as an entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals.

We highly recommend you checking in advance how your nationality and country/s you are visiting may be affected.

As of February 2026, dual British citizens travelling to the United Kingdom should carry either a valid British passport, or a Certificate of Entitlement to the Right of Abode, held digitally through a UKVI account and linked to a foreign passport. An ETA is not an alternative option. British citizens are not eligible for ETA's, even if they are travelling on a non-UK passport.

What should I consider when planning my personal expenses and discretionary spending for this itinerary?

Every traveller is different and therefore spending money requirements will vary. Some travellers may drink more than others while other travellers like to purchase more souvenirs than most. Please consider your own spending habits when it comes to allowing for drinks, shopping and tipping. Please also remember the following specific recommendations when planning your trip.

What should I know about currency, credit cards, and exchanging money while on this tour?

Credit cards and debit cards are very useful for cash advances. Visa cards are the most widely accepted cards. While ATMs are commonly available, there are no guarantees that your credit or debit cards will actually work. Check with your bank. You should be aware when purchasing products or services on a credit card, that a fee usually applies. Do not rely on credit or debit cards as your only source of money. A combination of Euros, Pounds, and cards is best. Always take more rather than less, as you don't want to spoil the trip by constantly feeling short of funds.

As currency exchange rates can fluctuate often we ask that you refer to the following website for daily exchange rates: www.xe.com

How much emergency money should I bring on this trip?

Please also make sure you have access to at least an additional USD \$200 (or equivalent) as an 'emergency' fund, to be used when circumstances outside our control (ex. a natural disaster) require a change to our planned route. This is a rare occurrence!

What activities are optional on this trip?

What rules should I know before joining this trip?

Illegal drugs will not be tolerated on any trips. Possessing or using drugs not only contravenes the laws of the land but also puts the rest of the group at risk. Smoking marijuana and opium is a part of local culture in some parts of the world but is not acceptable for our travellers. Our philosophy of travel is one of respect towards everyone we encounter and in particular the local people who make the world the special place it is. The exploitation of people in the sex trade is completely contrary to this philosophy. Our CEOs have the right to expel any member of the group if drugs are found in their possession or if they utilize the services of paid sex workers, in any capacity.

Is travel insurance required for my trip?

Travel insurance is compulsory in order to participate on any of our trips. When travelling on a group trip, you will not be permitted to join the group until evidence of travel insurance has been sighted by your leader, who will take note of your insurance details. When selecting a travel insurance policy we require that at a minimum you are covered for medical expenses including emergency evacuation and repatriation. A minimum coverage of USD200,000 is required. We strongly recommend that the policy also covers personal liability, cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects. Some tours include adventure activities that require extra coverage (e.g. crampon use); please review your itinerary and make sure that you are covered for all included activities. If you have credit card insurance we require proof of purchase of the trip (a receipt of credit card statement) with a credit card in your name. Contact your bank for details of their participating insurer, the level of coverage and emergency contact telephone number.
